



## Wanted: Volunteer Teaching Assistants for the Needham Community Education Summer Explorations Program!

**Do you like working with children?**

**Are you hoping to earn a Community Service credit this summer?**

If the answer to both questions is **YES**, then volunteering for the Needham Community Education Summer Explorations program may be a good fit for you!

Summer Explorations is comprised of over 90, half-day enrichment classes, for students entering grades 1–9. There are classes in science, sports, cooking, engineering, fine and performing arts, culture and technology. All classes are taught by Needham Public Schools staff members and other trained education professionals.

The weeklong classes are offered Monday–Friday, between July 2 and July 27 (no classes 7/4). Volunteers are needed for 3.25 hours/day, morning or afternoon, for a full week. If you volunteer in the mornings or afternoons for 2 weeks or for the morning AND the afternoon of one week, you will earn one Community Service credit.

**Summer Explorations Volunteer Teaching Assistant responsibilities include:**

- Assisting with student drop-off and pick-up
- Helping out in one of the classes
