- 9 Canvas Boards OR Stretched Canvas Panels; either 11" x 14" OR 12" x 16".
 (Only bring 2 Canvases to the first class.)
- Brushes for Acrylic Paint:
 - #8 Filbert (Long handle; bristles should be about 1" long/wide), #4 Filbert (Long handle), #6 Flat, #2 Round, #1 Round, #4 Bright, #2 Bright, #0 Liner
 - 2" Diamond Trowel Palette Knife (Metal or an inexpensive plastic one is fine)
- Acrylic paints (Grumbacher Academy Acrylic Paint will be used in class and is highly recommended;
 Liquitex, Winsor & Newton, etc. or other Basic or Student-Grade paint is acceptable, although please
 be aware that different paint brands with same-named colors often differ in appearance and
 pigment quality.) [Grumbacher Academy Acrylic Paint can be found at Michaels in store and online,
 and at www.DickBlick.com]
 - Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue, Thalo Blue, Cerulean Blue, Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Hooker's Green, *Paynes Grey, Yellow Ochre, Raw Umber, Burnt Sienna*.
 - Optional Colors: Napthol Crimson or Grumbacher Red; Ivory Black; Chrome Oxide Green;
 Dioxizine Purple; Cobalt Blue; Sap Green; Other Colors of Your Choice...
- Palette or wax-coated paper plates. Optional Recommended: Strathmore 9" x 12" Paper Palette.
- 1 Cup for Water. A regular cup will do. Optional Recommended: Loew Cornell Round Brush Tub.
- Roll of paper towels
- Optional: Smock/Apron, HB pencil, 12" ruler, and kneaded eraser; Table Easel.
