## **Materials for Watercolor by Sally Meding**

Basic supplies or the equivalent (that you already have) that we will be needing:

- 1 watercolor **palette** with large mixing area. (I use the Frank Webb palette (order #410-CheapJoes)~\$15. For complete beginners: Folding plastic palette (ord#03080-1001 DickBlick~\$5.
- 9x12" cold press 140lb Arches foldover pad of 100% cotton paper (\$12) (order#017-7001-CheapJoes) or (order#10183-1010-DickBlick). Not the heavy block with black glue along edges! (Also at Michaels and use their 50% coupon)
- #12 Black Velvet round brush (Silver Co). (order#SB3000-12) or (order#06196-1012-DickBlick) For complete beginners: Simply simmons #10 round brush (AC Moore) or (ord#06725-1010-DBlick)~ \$2.98
- 1" **flat** wash brush with <u>pony</u> hair (Simply Simmons flat wash with **clear** beveled handle) from Post Road Art Center, Marlboro or AC Moore. I will also have some available ~\$5
- #2 Rigger brush (order#CJWL-2-CheapJoes) or (order# 05566-7040-DickBlick-\$2).
- HB pencil (0.5mm mechanical), 12" ruler & kneaded eraser (eg. order#G139)
- Masking Fluid: Pebeo drawing gum brand (order#00364-1045-DickBlick) Optional for complete beginners.
- Natural rubber pick-up (order# RCR1) \$1.99 optional for complete beginners
- #2 Scrubber brush to lift any mistakes. (order#06711-1002-Dick Blick). Very Useful!

**12 Incidentials**- probably you have most of these at home already.

- Roll of paper towels (really important)
- Masking tape, (1" wide, cream)
- 11x14" piece of cardboard to "stretch" paper (2 pieces) and to lean on.
- Support: Small piece of 2x4" wood about 6" long to create a 15 degree slope (or 6" length of pool noodle, or styrofoam)
- Masters brush cleaner and preserver (1oz) (order# 05702-1001-DickBlick) (optional for complete beginners)
- 2 Water buckets -eg. old very large yogurt 32oz carton (Whole foods-large containers at salad bar work well too or 2 large drinking cups.
- Brush holder and stand for watercolor brushes which protects the points of brushes when not in use/in transit (order# CJBH002) optional but really useful. (A letter-sized piece of rolled cardboard and strong elastic band can suffice temporarily).
- Travel sized cosmetic misting bottle (eg from Christmas tree shop)
- Regular table salt and/or rock salt (in small baggie or shaker)
- Old bristle brush or toothbrush for textures (optional): I have a few to lend.
